
What a fantastic start to the year! The race calendar is in full swing with three races so far going ahead as scheduled. Mixed League and Ladies

There were also some promising results on the night:

8km Men Master - 4th place only 3 points behind 1st place.
4km Women Junior - 4th place only 3 points behind 1st place
4km Women Vets - 5th place only 4 points behind 1st place.
4km Women Master - 2nd place only 1 point behind 1st place.
4km Walkers - 1st place leading by 1 point.

This was followed on the 16th of January by the first leg of our "King and Queen of the Mountain" challenge at Ronnie Davel, hosted by Hilton Harriers. A couple of our braver members tackled the Scottsburgh 21.1km on the same day. Well done to all the members who entered, we are proud of you.

A club favourite... this year's Kearsney Striders Half Marathon and 10km, held on Sunday the 23rd of January, did not disappoint. The start was a sea of red and white, which in itself was such a joy to see, and the finish was even better with the gazebo set up and members staying on to cheer the finishers as they came through.

Special mention must be made to Hopewell Hlabe who finished 1st in the 21.1km 50-59 category with a stellar time of 1:38:07, as well as Margariet Wrethman who was the first female walker across the line and the 2nd walker overall in the 10km distance.

Again, there was a solid Westville turn out and some really impressive efforts by everyone who ran it; however the hero of the event was definitely Liz Chelin who entered the walk and finished 2nd in the Women's Walker category.
